Your Step One report and optional interview will have provided a unique perspective on you and your future.

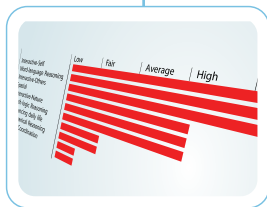
The careers report does not recommend specific individual careers, but instead favours broad possible career fields, from which to begin your own investigations.

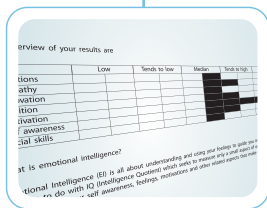
These other facilities, which you may not have completed the first time around, are available at a minimal cost and are all completed online:
